Where in the World Am I?

You are going to make game for us to guess where you are in the world using iPhoto and pictures from pics4learning. You will create this project in 3 formats. A slideshow, a book, and a webpage.

- Open Safari and go to: <http://www.pics4learning.com/>
- Choose a photo category and find pictures of some place in the world.
- Choose 4 or 5 pictures and download them to your computer. Put them in a folder inside your Pictures folder.
- Open iPhoto
- Go to the Menu bar >File>Import. Navigate to the Pictures folder. Select the pictures and import.
- Import the book cover that I put on your desktop.
- Go to the Menu bar>File>New Album and create and name a new album on the left.
- Drag the pictures from the Photo Library window to the new album on the left. This makes an alias to the original photo it does not move the original.
- Select the album that contains your photos and the cover.
- Move your pictures around to the order you want them.

To Create a Slide Show:



- Click on the Slideshow button icon



- Click on the Music button to select a song.
- To start your slide show click the play button.
- You do not need to Save in iPhoto. It will automatically save.

To Create a Book:

- Select the same album you used for the slide show, but this time select the Book option.
- Choose your theme.
- Drag your photos from the top frame into your book pages.

To create a Webpage:

- Select the same album, but this time select iWeb and then select Photo page.
- (If it asks for a .mac account - call Roberto or Linda for help.)
- Select the photo page when the option appears.
- You can select the nonsense text and replace it with real text.

For this exercise, you will just save the iWeb file. If you were going to put it on the web, you would then go to File>Publish to .Mac, or Publish to Folder depending on what you were doing with the page.

Class photo pages can publish to .Mac. Class projects such as WebQuests will save to a folder and will be stored on our web server.
